



One of the first major team sports tournaments after the Lunar New Year will be the Phoenix Cup 2009 pitting against each other the top women's baseball teams of the Asian Pacific region, namely those from Australia, Japan, Korea, Chinese Taipei, Hong Kong and a composite squad from North America. Phoenix is of course a mythical bird which rises from the ashes and it is an apt metaphor for a region that rebounds again and again from whatever crisis which besets it at the moment. Sports too have their rejuvenating power in rallying the people to hope from despair and unity from division. Baseball is one of those games that galvanizes in drawing together different communities, a sport that broke the race barrier in the United States, one that inspired legions during the Great Depression and one that evoked, and evoke, still times innocent gone by. Women too have played the game not only with gusto but with a purpose greater even than the sport itself as depicted in the film, "League of Their Own", based on a true life story which demonstrated how during the Second World War the feminine gender not only worked on the assembly lines in place of the men folk away in combat overseas but kept alive the sport that brought so much relief and even gaiety to their nation. The Phoenix Cup is a way a celebration of the heroics of women in every facet of life and those of us, who are the men, are ever so grateful and cannot in good conscience begrudge them of their dues earned through toil and sometimes heartbreaks. On February 14<sup>th</sup>, St Valentine's Day, let our hearts be worn on our sleeves for the commencement of the Phoenix Cup and in salute to those who play with all their skills as well as all their hearts.

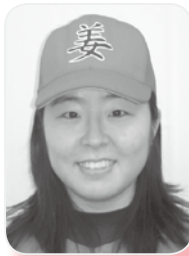
As pioneers of Korean women's baseball, TOP leads the field in spreading and promoting women's baseball in Korea despite its relatively short history.
